Drummond, Young-Adult Music Novel Challenges Book Bannings with Surreptitiously Non-Religious Protagonist

SYRACUSE, NEW YORK — Drummond: Learning to find himself in the music is a young adult novel by Patrick R. F. Blakley, a native of Syracuse, New York. His novel utilizes marching band to help young readers find who they are inside, then use that information to fit in. Using music as a starting point, the book guides its readers to think about some larger life events. It also helps readers learn to ask questions and seek out new information for developing a better specific understanding. The writing subtly shows how extraneous religion can be by drawing careful parallels to music. This subtlety is what underscores the story and also derides book bannings across the country. Drummond has been donated to several US counties that have persistently banned similar books.

Drummond tells the story of a young drummer who tries desperately to fit in by pursuing brass and woodwind instruments (with the help of some new friends). After some humorous and frustrating failures, he eventually realizes he fits nicely in the drumline and that this solution was staring him in the face all along. The story is loosely based on Blakley's own experience joining marching band as a teen and his personal journey through life navigating some noteworthy topics outside of music. At release, the eBook became an Amazon.com #1 best seller in four different categories. The novel has also received several five-star professional reviews and multiple book awards.
